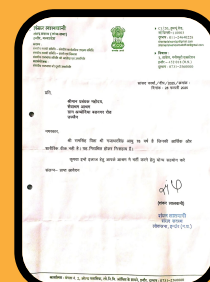

SEWADHAM'S HEALING TOUCH: A NEW LIFE FOR CRITICAL RAM SINGH JI



On March 3, 2025, on the recommendation of Shri Neeraj Kumar Singh, IAS, Collector Ujjain, through Sabir Ahmed Siddiqui Ji (Assistant Director, Women & Child Development Department, Ujjain) and Lok Sabha Member, MP, Shri Shankar Lalwani Ji, Indore & Shri Madhu Verma, MLA, Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly; Ram Singh Dev (Father – Gajadhar Singh Dev, Age – 78, Resident of Bihar) was admitted to the ashram in critical condition. His body had multiple wounds on which dressing was done by Sudhir Bhai. Earlier, Ram Singh had undergone thigh bone surgery, and metal rod was implanted. Due to severe wounds and complications from diabetes, the rod was coming out. The ashram immediately sent him to Ujjain Civil Hospital, from where he was transferred to Indore M.Y. Hospital on March 19, 2025.

On April 1, 2025, he underwent another surgery, and on April 2, 2025, he was discharged and brought back to the ashram. Although not fully recovered, the ashram caregivers provided round-the-clock care and support. Today, Shri Ram Singh Dev remains critical but is feeling better than before.
