PADMA SHRI DR. DHARAMPAL SAINI HONORED WITH THE 27TH 'KRANTIVEER SAMMAN'


The 'Krantiveer Samman', awarded annually in memory of freedom fighter Shri Ramchandra Raghuvanshi 'Kakaji', father of the event's chief organizer Dr. Prakash Raghuvanshi, was presented this year to Padma Shri Dr. Dharampal Saini — renowned as the Gandhi and Vinoba of Bastar. Dr. Saini has led a revolutionary movement for the education of girls in the Naxal-affected regions. The event was graced by many distinguished guests, including Municipal Corporation President Smt.
