NAVRATRI FESTIVAL: COMPLETION OF YAGNA AND SPECIAL RITUALS

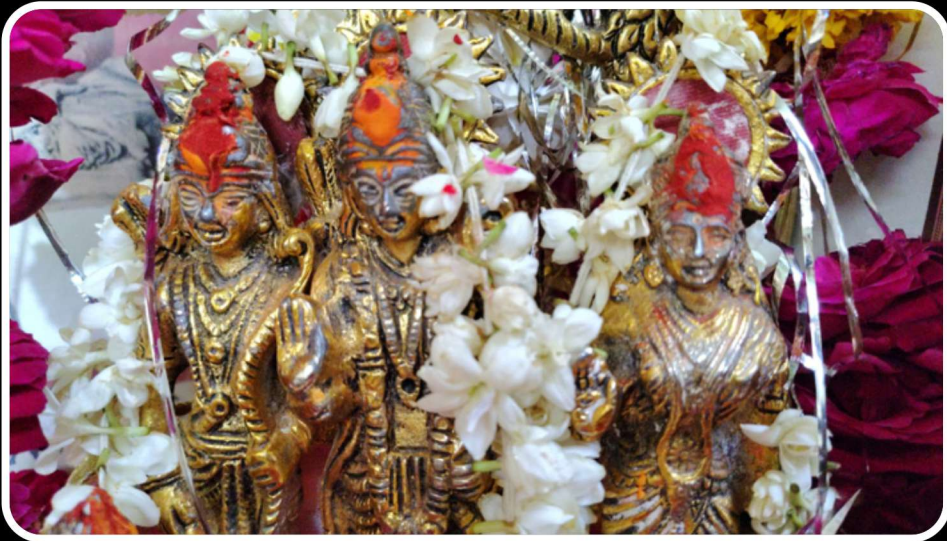
