Mayanath came alone, but Sewadham sent her off with dignity. This is the soul of the Ashram—where every soul receives honor, even in their final moments.


Oath-Taking Ceremony Of Shri All India Shwetamber Sthanakvasi Jain Conference (M.P.) Held Successfully


